What to Bring to the Parent Interview

- Payment (check made payable to Neurobehavior Services)
- Completed Consent for Testing or Consent for Consultation form
- Recent photo
- Completed background questionnaire
- Names, email addresses, and direct phone numbers for each teacher and/or professional you would like to involve in the assessment
- All applicable and relevant records*
 - Academic records (report cards, progress reports, teacher comments, conference notes) from all grades including preschool/kindergarten and the current quarter or semester
 - Standardized testing from all years, as applicable
 - Prior evaluations, if applicable (e.g. testing/evaluations performed at school or privately, evaluations and progress reports done in the context of treatment/intervention)
 - Individualized Education Plan (IEP) documents, if applicable
 - Pertinent medical records, if applicable

* If you are not sure what records are relevant, please bring everything you have, and Dr. Turnbull will select what she needs.
